WHAT'S INCLUDED IN EACH ROOM:

- Bed

Kitchen amenities include a toaster, stove top oven, fridge, vending machine and sink. The Caroline Hall front desk offers a variety of board games, two Blu-Ray players, ping pong equipment for use in the lounges, and kitchen equipment.

WHAT TO PACK

CLOSET



- Hamper or laundry basket
- Hangers
- Quarters for laundry (\$1.75 to wash, \$1.75 to dry)
- Laundry detergent, dryer sheets
- Seasonal clothing and shoes

BATHROOM



- Brush, hair dryer, curler, straightener, and hair products
- Bathrobe
- Shower supplies and shower shoes
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Cosmetics/makeup
- Cleaning supplies: sprays, broom, mop
- Shower caddy (suggested if you are sharing a bathroom)

BEDROOM



- Sheets (twin XL sheets)
- Comforter
- Pillow(s)
- Mattress Pad
- Towels (bring extras for emergencies)
- Extra seating: beanbag, futon
- First aid: Band-Aids, necessary medication
- Small dry erase or bulletin board
- Alarm clock
- Area rug
- Garbage can
- Tool kit
- Extension cords and power strips
- Cable cord
- TV
- Fan
- Batteries

SCHOOL SUPPLIES



- Backpack
- Planner
- Laptop and laptop accessories
- USB flash drive
- Phone charger
- Pencils, pens and highlighters
- Notebooks, folders and binders
- Tape

- Games

KITCHEN SUPPLIES



- Plates, bowls and cups
- Tupperware and plastic bags for leftovers
- Silverware
- Cooking utensils (pans, pots, spatula, oven mitt etc. – these items are also available for check-out at the front desk of Caroline Hall)
- Dish rack
- Dish soap + sponge or brush
- Paper towel

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

- All pets, except for fish. Fish tanks must be less than 10 gallons in size.
- Any appliance over 6 amps (700 watts)
- Any appliance with an exposed heating element – including coffee makers without automatic shutoff, personal grills, panini or quesadilla makers, candles, candle warmers, incense
- Duct tape, screws or nails
- Hot plates or deep fryers
- Microwaves (already comes included in your room)
- Mini-fridges (already comes included in your room)
- Space heaters or air conditioners
- Toaster
