# UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS ADMISSION INFORMATION

## FIRST YEAR STUDENTS, TRANSFER STUDENTS AND EVENING STUDENTS

Students who wish to earn an undergraduate degree must have earned a high school diploma or the equivalent. All students except those who already have a bachelor's degree must submit high school transcripts. Official transcripts of all post-secondary work must also be submitted. For more information, please go to [Mount Mary University Admissions](#).

## ACCELERATED COURSES AND PROGRAMS

To be eligible for the accelerated program, a student must be admitted to the University and meet the following criteria:

- an age level of 24 or more years;
- at least two years of full-time work experience or the equivalent; (work experience while a full-time student is not sufficient)

Exceptions to the eligibility criteria, based on the degree to which the applicant has been living a self-supporting, independent lifestyle, are considered on an individual basis.

For students who wish to take accelerated courses but are not in an accelerated program, permission must be granted by Beth Vogel, 333 Fidelis Hall, 414-258-4810 Ext. 476. Normally such approvals require a minimum of one week's notice.

### ❖ Required First Class Assignment

Accelerated courses have an assignment due at the beginning of the class the first night/Saturday of class. In order to complete this assignment, students must obtain their textbook and course syllabus from the Mount Mary University Bookstore prior to the first class. The syllabi and books, for the starting term, will be in the bookstore about 2 weeks before the start of the first class.

## NON-DEGREE SEEKING STUDENTS/ ADVANCED LEVEL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Students who possess a minimum of a high school diploma or its equivalent, or an advanced high school student with special permission of the high school and the University, may take a limited number of courses at Mount Mary University without being regularly admitted. Please contact the Admission Office for more information. For students who have not taken a Mount Mary University class before, a [Special Student application form](#) must be completed online. When that is successfully processed, an id number and directions to create a unique password will be sent to the student. Special students may then register online ([My Mount Mary](#)). Special students are subject to the same prerequisites for courses as any other student at the University. Each student's selection of courses will be reviewed on an individual basis. Placement testing may be required for admission into certain classes.

## POST-BACCALAUREATE STUDIES

Students with undergraduate degrees may earn a major certificate or a second bachelor's degree. Students pursuing a major certificate must complete the [Undergraduate Post-baccalaureate Certificate/Second Degree Application](#) form and submit all official college or university transcripts. They also must satisfy all admission requirements in force for transfer students, have departmental approval, and fulfill the requirements of the major.

Students pursuing a second bachelor's degree must satisfy all admission requirements for transfer students; provide official transcripts from each college or university attended; earn at least 32 credits at Mount Mary University beyond the completion of studies for the first degree; maintain a C (2.0) average and fulfill the requirements of the major. Please contact the Admission Office for further details.

## **TRANSFER CREDITS FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS**

Official transcripts should be sent to the Admission Office from all institutions where credits have been earned. Credits taken prior to enrolling at Mount Mary University will not be accepted for transfer after the student's first semester as a matriculant. All students, except those who already have a bachelor's degree, must submit high school transcripts. Credits from other accredited institutions are accepted for transfer if the student received a grade of "C" or above and if the course would be accepted as part of Mount Mary's current curriculum. If credit for a major course was earned many years ago, the student may be asked to update the credit by taking a current course in the same area. ## **GRADUATE PROGRAMS ADMISSION INFORMATION**

### **GRADUATE ADMISSION**

For information about applying to the Graduate programs in Art Therapy, Business Administration, Counseling, Dietetics, Education, English, or Occupational Therapy, please contact the Office for Graduate Programs (NDH 152). Dietetics, Education, and Occupational Therapy require an undergraduate degree and professional experience.

Students registering for any course numbered 500 or above (graduate credit) are required to hold a bachelor's degree.

### **NON-DEGREE SEEKING GRADUATE STUDENTS**

Students who possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree may take a limited number of courses at Mount Mary University without being regularly admitted. These students are assigned Special Student status. Special students are subject to the same prerequisites for courses as any other student at the University. Each student's selection of courses will be approved on an individual basis. Graduate special students are allowed to take graduate classes on a space available basis, after degree-seeking students have registered. ### **LATE REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS**

Graduate students who register after August 23, 2014 will be assessed a late fee of \$52.00.

### **TRANSFER CREDITS FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS**

Official transcripts should be sent to the Office for Graduate Programs (NDH 152) from all institutions where credits have been earned. Credits taken prior to enrolling at Mount Mary University will not be accepted for transfer after the student's first semester as a matriculant. All students must submit official transcripts for courses they wish to transfer. Credits from other regionally accredited institutions are accepted for graduate transfer if the student received a grade of "B" or better and if the course is approved by the Graduate Program Director. If credit for a major course was earned more than seven years ago, the student may be asked to update the credit by taking a current course in the same area. ### TUITION DEPOSIT POLICY

Prior to registration, **all new students are required to pay a \$200 tuition deposit (non-refundable)**. It is to be submitted to the Admission Office and will be applied toward tuition. Financial Aid may not be used as a source to pay the deposit.

### TUITION

Tuition for regular, full-time students includes academic instruction, lectures, laboratories, and student and academic support services. It also includes subscriptions to University publications and membership in the student government.

## **TUITION REDUCTIONS AND DISCOUNTS**

All tuition reductions and discounts are calculated using the current regular tuition rate per credit. Summer school courses are excluded from tuition reductions and discounts (except for School Sisters of Notre Dame, as noted below). Reductions and discounts cannot be combined. Special tuition schedules are as follows.

- Individuals holding baccalaureate degrees from Mount Mary University: 50% tuition discount on undergraduate courses, with a maximum of four credits each semester.
- Auditors: No tuition charge for full-time students, 50% tuition discount for part-time and non-degree seeking students.
- Senior citizens (62 and over): 50% tuition discount, with a maximum of four credits each semester.
- School Sisters of Notre Dame: No tuition charge for a maximum of eight credits per semester, or six credits during a summer session. (Note: this waiver does not apply to independent study, thesis credits, private lessons, course supplies and course fees.)
- Spouses and dependents of full-time employees of Mount Mary University: No tuition charge. Please consult the employee handbook. (Note: this waiver does not apply to independent study, thesis credits, private lessons, course supplies and course fees.)

## **HEALTH INSURANCE**

The University requires every full-time student (non-accelerated/ non-doctoral programs), international student, student athlete, and residence hall student to have health insurance. Students who already have health insurance and opt not to participate in Mount Mary's student health insurance plan must provide proof of coverage by filling out a Waiver Form. Students who do not have coverage and/or do not submit a Waiver will automatically be entered into the Mount Mary student health insurance plan upon enrollment. ## **ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPTS**

A student may obtain an official transcript of records online at [National Student Clearinghouse](#) or through [My Mount Mary](#) with login and password. Transcripts are \$7.25 on the web for 4-day turnaround time and \$15.00 for immediate transcripts at the Office of the Registrar. Unofficial transcripts are available through My Mount Mary at no charge. Transcripts are not available for students with outstanding tuition, room and board balances, or other bills, or for students who have not returned all materials checked out from the library.

## **AUDIT CHARGES**

Full-time credit students (undergraduate or graduate) are permitted to register for "audits" without incurring additional tuition charge. Part-time credit students or students registering only for "audits" are charged 50% of the regular tuition for the audited course(s). Audit students are responsible for all added expenses associated with the course: books, fees, materials, etc.

## **TUITION/FEE PAYMENTS**

Mount Mary University reserves the right to make adjustments in costs without advance notice. Tuition, room and board, and all other fees reflect charges in effect at the time of publication.

Mount Mary University provides two options for payment of tuition:

- Payment in full by the due date on invoice. Cash or check accepted in the Business Office. Credit card or e-check accepted online through <https://my.mtmary.edu/ICS/>. (Log into *My Mount Mary* and then click on the blue “Finances” tab.)
- Enrollment in the payment plan. A sign-up fee may be required, according to the following guideline: **No charge** if approved before the start of the semester or at registration, **\$25** if approved between days 1-15 of the semester, **\$50** afterwards).

Payment plans must be arranged with the Mount Mary University Business Office at 414-256-0165 within two weeks after receiving a tuition invoice.

Each semester's account balance must be paid in full one month prior to the end of the semester. *A student may not register for a subsequent semester nor occupy a room in the residence hall until all past due invoices are paid. A student who is delinquent in tuition/fee payments (including library and parking fines, etc.) is not entitled to grades, credits, transcripts, a diploma or participation in graduation exercises.*

## SPECIFIC ACADEMIC FEES

- **Liability Insurance**

  - Other professional liability insurance fees may apply as required by department.

  - Varies. Certain courses will require a background check based on state caregiver law for students in practica, internships or fieldwork placement.

## **GRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE SCHEDULE CHANGES, WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURES, AND REFUNDS**

### **ADDING AND DROPPING SEMESTER CLASSES**

Schedule changes are made in the Registrar's Office or online. Students may add or drop semester courses online through the first week of class with no financial penalty (**Tuesday, September 2, 2014**).

Semester classes may be dropped until the drop deadline, **Tuesday, November 10, 2014**. Students are academically and financially responsible for courses in which they are enrolled. If dropping a course becomes necessary, a student may drop the class online until September 2, or thereafter must file the "Change of Course" form available online or from the Office of the Registrar in Notre Dame Hall, Room 153. **Ceasing to attend class, notifying the instructor or non-payment of tuition does not constitute authorized dropping of a course; such actions will result in academic and/or financial penalty, including a grade of "F" and liability for full tuition payment.** If adding a course results in additional credits, the tuition and fees will apply as they would from the first day of class.

### **FULL SEMESTER PROGRAMS-TUITION REFUND SCHEDULE**

Schedule changes are made in the Registrar's Office or online. Students may add or drop semester courses online through the first week of class with no financial penalty (**Tuesday, September 2, 2014**).

Semester classes may be dropped until the drop deadline, **Monday, November 10, 2014**. Each student is academically and financially responsible for courses in which she or he is enrolled. If dropping a course becomes necessary, a student may drop the class online until September 2, or thereafter must file the "Change of Course" form available online or from the Office of the Registrar in Notre Dame Hall, Room 153. **Ceasing to attend class, notifying the instructor or non-payment of tuition does not constitute authorized dropping of a course; such actions will result in academic and/or financial penalty, including a grade of "F" and liability for full tuition payment.** If adding a course results in additional credits, the tuition and fees will apply as they would from the first day of class.

Refunds follow the schedule below, and are based on the percentage of class meetings that have occurred, NOT on classes attended by the individual student. The date of the drop is determined by the date on which the student submits the required “Change of Course” form.

A student receiving financial aid must check with the Financial Aid Office to understand the impact of withdrawal on the student’s financial aid situation before withdrawing. Mount Mary University is obligated to follow federal, state and private donor guidelines regarding financial aid refund calculations, and any funds returned to the source will be invoiced to the recipient. **NOTE:** Refunds are based on the percentage of class meetings that have occurred, NOT on classes attended by the individual student.

### **GRADUATE STUDENT STOP OUT**

Graduate students who do not register for courses for up to three consecutive semesters (excluding summer school) have the option to stop out. At any point within the three consecutive semesters, the student will maintain mtmary.edu email access and may register for courses. A student who does not register for courses within the three consecutive semesters will be administratively withdrawn from the College and must file an application for re-entry with the Office for Graduate Education.

### **WITHDRAWING FROM THE UNIVERSITY-TUITION POLICIES**

All withdrawals from the University must be done through the Dean for Academic Affairs (NDH 151). The date of withdrawal is determined by the date on which the student submits the required withdrawal form to the Dean for Academic Affairs (NDH 151).

Students will receive refunds for tuition according to the above schedule, based on the date of official withdrawal. The tuition deposits of \$200 for new undergraduate students (including transfer students) and \$206 for new Occupational Therapy masters students and Art Therapy doctoral students are non-refundable.

Room charges are refundable based on the above schedule. In establishing rates, consideration has been given to expected absenteeism; no allowance can be made for meals missed during the term.

### **GRADE REPORTS**

Student grade reports will be available through My Mount Mary at the end of the term. Reports will not be available for students with outstanding tuition, room and board balances, or other bills, or for students who have not returned all materials checked out from the library.

# UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE FINANCIAL AID

## REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Students receiving financial aid must be registered for the number of credits for which their most recent financial aid award was based on before any financial aid can be disbursed. Registered credits will be verified two weeks prior to the first day of classes. Audited courses do not count toward credits attempted for financial aid purposes. Financial aid is posted to students' accounts on the first day of classes or later for each semester. All financial aid funds are applied to student accounts in the Business Office. Students are required to pay all charges and fees in full before receiving any refund of excess financial aid funds.

## REFUND/REPAYMENT POLICY

Students who withdraw from the University may be entitled to a refund of a portion of their tuition and fees based on the date of their withdrawal. (See Tuition Refund Policies above.) All refunds are processed by the Business Office and the Financial Aid Office. Students who have received financial aid funds may be required to pay back a portion of their financial aid. The actual payment will be determined by the Financial Aid Office.

**Contact the Financial Aid Office prior to dropping a class or withdrawing from the University to determine what effect it will have on your financial aid.**

## SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Whenever students may decide to apply for federal financial aid, their entire academic performance will be evaluated to determine satisfactory academic progress standards. Students are eligible for financial aid for up to a maximum of 12 semesters and must be making satisfactory academic progress toward a degree to continue to be eligible for financial aid. A copy of Mount Mary University's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for financial aid recipients is available upon request from the Financial Aid Office.
