

## Accessing Your Library Account 24/7

Haggerty Library | Mount Mary University

Everyone at Mount Mary University has a library account. Use your **MMU ID card** to check out library materials or to **access library databases off campus 24/7**. To log in, choose **Off-Campus Login** or **Local Library Catalog** on our [library home page](#). Then you'll see [TOPCAT](#), the shared library catalog of the [SWITCH Library Consortium](#), consisting of 8 smaller Milwaukee-area academic libraries. SWITCH also provides Haggerty Library users' off-campus access.

Whether you click the link mentioned above, or you click on any database or journal off-campus, you will see a screen similar to one of these:

**Password:** haggerty

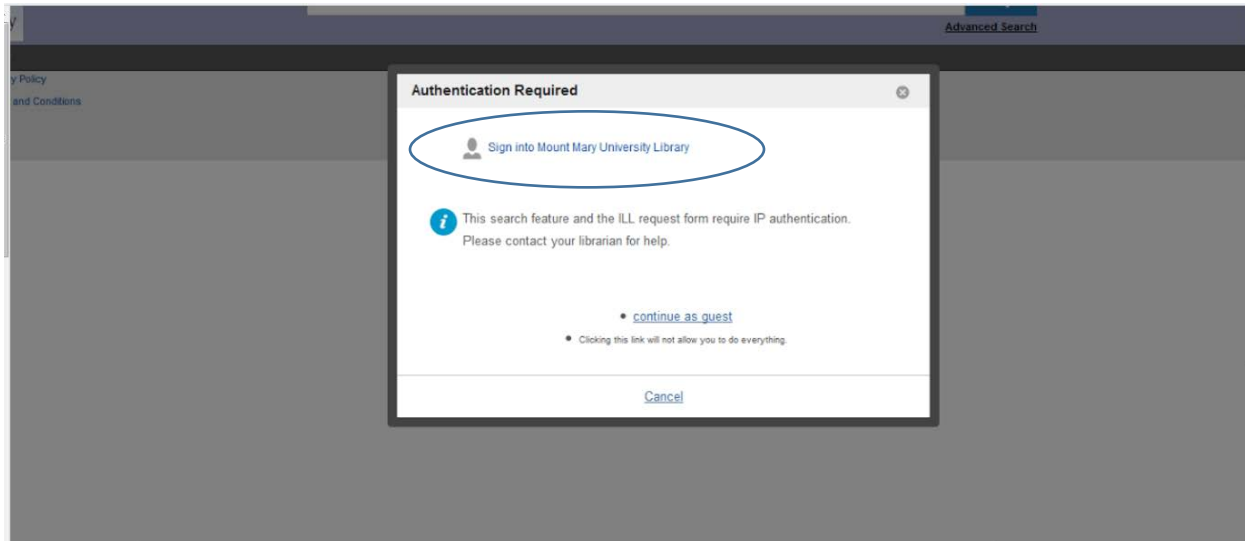
Once logged in, you can change your password to whatever you'd like, but your user name will remain the same.

**Please note** that this is a separate login to WorldCat, so even in if you have already logged in via TOPCAT to use databases, you must log in here as well. But you will also stay logged in here unless you close your browser.
